Pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the FPFCU Bylaws:

- ...nominations for vacancies may also be made by petition signed by one percent of the members with a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 500 (at least 42 signatures would be required to comply).

Such petitions must be received by the Secretary of Financial Partners Federal Credit Union no later than **Tuesday, April 17, 2018**. Any such nominee shall be required to provide a written statement of qualifications, biographical data and signed certificate that they are agreeable to the nomination and that they will serve if elected to office.
